Hopetoun House is situated just 20 minutes (8 miles) West of Edinburgh at South Queensferry, and easily accessible from the South side of the new Queensferry Bridge, Hopetoun House is a magnificent, privately owned Stately Home standing in 6,500 acres adjacent to The Forth of Forth.

Designed by William Bruce and extended by William Adam, Hopetoun has been occupied since the 1600's by the Hope family. It is recognized as one of the outstanding examples of 18th Century architecture in Scotland.
